If you are Restorative Conference trained and are looking to enhance your skills to be able to facilitate cases of a sensitive and complex nature, this is the course for you. Building on the foundations of our Being a Restorative Conference Faclitator we will explore the additional skills necessary to support individuals affected by crimes such as murder, manslaughter, death by dangerous driving, rape and sexual assault.

We will also look at techniques and methods for working with bereavement and how to develop a trauma informed approach to all your practice.

#### **Restorative Practice and Domestic Abuse**

#### **Oct 17th, 18th**

The use of Restorative Practice for domestic abuse is a controversial subject. In this course we explore the concerns about its use and also the benefits, using real case examples. Over two days, we will look at the extra knowledge, skills and sometimes counterintuitive procedures needed to deliver Restorative Justice in domestic abuse cases safely.

We will share the safety building models we have developed drawing on best practices used by partner agencies working in the domestic abuse field. The ultimate aim will be to ensure Restorative Justice is inclusive, accessible and safe, fitting with the Code of Practice for Victims requirement for all victim has to be given the opportunity to explore Restorative Justice.
